



Conferencing and Collaboration Videoconferencing Dial Plan

The dial plan for videoconferencing consist of a 10 digit string of numbers, 0-9. The first 3 digits (prefix) was established by CENIC. The 3 digit prefix for COEs is the number "5" followed by the 2 digit CDS county code. Below is the list of the prefixes for counties.

The fourth digit of the dial string can be any number except for "0". It is highly recommended that you plan how the dial string is distributed to schools in the county. Below is an example of how one county is distributing the dial string.
